TOUCAN RESCUE RANCH

The Toucan Rescue Ranch's (TRR) mission is to rescue, rehabilitate, and release Costa Rica wildlife. TRR works with a model that focuses on conservation, education, and research to ensure a brighter tomorrow for Costa Rica wildlife. TRR's emphasis is on the care, rehabilitation, and release of national wildlife. We receive and care for confiscated, sick, and injured animals from government agencies.

The Toucan Rescue Ranch works closely with the Ministry of Environment and Energy of Costa Rica (MINAE) who brings injured and displaced wildlife to the center. TRR provides sanctuary while giving treatment and rehabilitation. Whenever possible the animal is released to their natural environment.

The Toucan Rescue Ranch is a licensed Costa Rica wildlife rescue facility, Costa Rica foundation (300667701803) and a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization (EIN: 80-0516453).





INTERNSHIP DESCRIPTION

The Animal Husbandry & Zookeeping Intern is responsible to complete the daily feeding and care of Toucan Rescue Ranch. This intern has primary responsibility for ensuring animals are fed and enclosures are clean. You will work closely with the Kitchen & Animal Care Employee, who is responsible for food preparation. This intern participates in feeding, cleaning, and provides direction to short-term volunteers helping with these activities. This Intern will help oversee general maintenance and repairs of the property.

Will work with TRR's biologist on enrichment activities. As well as train Toucan Team Volunteers and manage the enclosure cleaning schedule.

SKILLS YOU WILL LEARN

- Handling techniques for a variety of species.
- Gain an understanding of each species-specific nutrition, environment and animal behavior.
- Enrichment building and knowledge.
- Learn and take part in the rehabilitation and release processes.
- Leadership skills.
- Time management and organizational skills.
- Exposure to the running of a wildlife center.
- Construction skills, including woodwork, use of electric tools and joining techniques.

ACTIVITIES & RESPONSABILITIES

Animal Husbandry:

- Provide fresh water daily.
- Prepare and provide the complete nutritional diet to the permanent residents at the sanctuary.
- Prepare carnivore diets. This will include handling dead prey and butchering meat.
- Clean enclosures to a high standard.









- Daily observations of the animals, carrying out health checks. Communicating with the Husbandry coordinator and /or Vets if concerns are raised.
- Complete daily rounds at the beginning and end of each shift and ensure there are no safety hazards in the enclosures.
- Monitor individuals that are being evaluated for release.
- Collect wild diet for release candidates.
- Participate in general maintenance and construction of enclosures.
- Create enrichment for the sanctuary animals.
- Dispose of organic waste and maintain compost area to a cleanly standard.
- Clean, feed, and take care of the Bioterium animals.

Administrative Work:

- Welcome Interns and Volunteers into the Volunteer/Intern house.
- Train new volunteers to a professional quality, so they can independently complete the tasks required of them.
- Lead the team throughout the day and ensure all husbandry tasks are carried out.

REQUIREMENTS & QUALIFICATIONS

General Requirements:

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Provide proof of emergency health insurance while in Costa Rica.
- Provide proof of at least 2 COVID-19 vaccines.
- Provide proof of current tetanus and rabies (recommended) vaccinations.
- The ability to follow directions with attention to detail.
- A positive "can-do" attitude and the ability to work well in a team environment.









Specific Requirements:

- Fluent in English. Basic or intermediate Spanish.
- Studying an animal related discipline or have some experience working with animals.
- Have excellent communication skills.
- Have a strong interest in animal welfare and conservation.
- Moderate degree of fitness.

Other valuable skills:

- First aid course is highly recommended.
- Experience traveling to a tropical country, living in remote conditions are preferred.
- Experience working with wildlife is a plus.

Ensuring best practice implementation:

- Fostering practices that support and improve the Ranch's philosophy and goals.
- Maintaining quality by establishing and enforcing organization standards.

WORK SCHEDULE

The Intern works 5 days a week with two days off a week. Days off are not necessarily on the weekend. You will learn about your schedule and days off during your orientation at the Toucan Rescue Ranch.









INTERNSHIP PROGRAM BENEFITS AND COSTS

We have tried to keep our internships free to make them available to the widest range of people. But as costs keep increasing and income from tourism varies, we must implement fees to maintain our operations. The fee is about \$30 a day and covers room and board costs as well as the education you will receive. We continue to improve and expand our facilities and staff providing you with an excellent learning environment. Your fee contributes to the medical care, food, and general husbandry of the animals in our care.

Cost: \$3600. 50% off limited time. \$1800

Housing: provided by TRR. Includes utilities and Wifi.

Meals: Meals are provided 7-days a week. We will show you the local stores where you can buy additional food to supplement your meals. Please let us know if you are vegetarian, vegan, or have special dietary requirements.

Other: All other costs are to be paid for by the intern. This includes travel and immigration expenses, medical insurance, and entertainment expenses
